Re: Unauthorized use of Palo Alto Networks Products & Trademarks; Cease and Desist

Dear Mr. Avi Shua,

Palo Alto Networks, Inc. and its affiliates (collectively "Palo Alto Networks") is the owner of several trademarks, copyrights and patents for Palo Alto Networks, its logo, and its products and services in jurisdictions throughout the world. It has come to our attention that Palo Alto Networks Prisma Cloud is being misused by you in connection with the content you created at <https://orca.security/prisma-cloud-security/>, comparing and rating Palo Alto Networks Prisma Cloud and Orca Security products ("Orca Violation").

Orca's comparison and rating of Prisma Cloud and the public dissemination of such comparison is a clear breach of Section 2(c)(vi) of the End User Agreement prohibiting an end user from disclosing, publishing or otherwise making publicly available any benchmark, performance or comparison tests that an end user or a third party contracted by end user run on Palo Alto Networks products, in whole or in part. In order to access Prisma Cloud, Orca or one of its representatives were required to click through and agree to the End User Agreement, thereby making Orca an end user subject not only to such End User Agreement, but also to our Terms of Service. Orca's use of Palo Alto Networks products and/or services for a performance and comparison test is thereby unauthorized and a breach of contract. Furthermore, we view the use and rating of Prisma Cloud on your website as materially misleading as the tests and ratings are not fair and consistent.

Finally, Palo Alto Networks considers its copyrights and trademarks and the associated goodwill to be an important part of its intellectual property portfolio. It has come to our attention that the Palo Alto Networks name and logo are being misused on your website in connection with the Orca Violation.

It is the above described unauthorized uses that has prompted our letter to you.

The Palo Alto Networks logo and/or name posted on your website at <https://orca.security/prisma-cloud-security/> are registered European Union trademarks (Reg. No. 006053037 and Reg. No. 012497897, respectively) owned by Palo Alto Networks. Your use of our logo and any reference to Palo Alto Networks on the above-mentioned website is unauthorized and is a violation of our intellectual property rights. We view the misuse of our trademarked name and/or logo on your website as materially misleading and believe

it constitutes a fraudulent misrepresentation that Palo Alto Networks has approved and authorized the use of your services and website and that Palo Alto Networks has a relationship with Orca Security and/or any of the other websites affiliated with it.

Accordingly, we request that Orca Security and every person, agent, company or other entity or website affiliated with it immediately cease and desist from: (i) all use of the Palo Alto Networks logo, business name, and all other Palo Alto Networks intellectual property; (ii) remove all content on any Orca Security website or webpage which compares or rates any Palo Alto Networks products including without limitation the content found at <https://orca.security/prisma-cloud-security/>; (iii) distributing, showcasing, or otherwise using any content found at <https://orca.security/prisma-cloud-security/> or any similar comparative content to any prospective Orca Security customers. Furthermore, we request that, no later than 11 September 2020, Orca provide written assurances that it has affirmatively ceased all use and reference to Palo Alto Networks and Palo Alto Networks' products.

Please note that this letter does not purport to be a complete statement of the law or facts and is without prejudice to Palo Alto Networks' legal and equitable rights, which are expressly reserved.

Thank you in advance for your attention to this matter and we await a prompt reply.
